PARISH SAFEGUARDING —Volunteer DBS Checks

Hello all,

This is a reminder for our parish volunteers working with children, young people, or vulnerable adults, that they need to have an enhanced DBS check.

This should be renewed every 3 years.

The process is straightforward and offered at no cost to volunteers.

DBS checks issued on behalf of other organisations may be valid for your volunteer role in the parish but will still need to be verified.
