## EASTER DUTY

All Catholics are obliged to receive the Holy Eucharist at least once a year and that at Easter or thereabouts. It is also recommended to go to Confession (although this is without obligation). The time for making Easter Duties runs from Ash Wednesday to Trinity Sunday.

## WEDNESDAY

Is the Solemnity of St. Joseph and so Lenten penances are dispensed.

## STATION MASS

During Lent the Bishop visits each Deanery to celebrate Mass with the people. Our Deanery Station Mass is on Thursday at Holy Family Church. There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 6pm with various priests available for Confession. Mass is at 7pm followed by a simple supper.
