From Bishop Peter

As we complete the Nine Days of Official Mourning, days when
we have offered our prayers for the eternal repose of our late
Holy Father, Pope Francis, the Universal Church now invokes a
particular outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the College of
Cardinals. The Cardinals have already been meeting in
'Congregation', including those who are over eighty years of age,
to reflect and discuss prayerfully in preparation for the Conclave.
The Cardinal Electors, those under eighty years of age, will enter
Conclave on the 7th of May. I call upon every member of this
Local Church, the Diocese of East Anglia, to join me over the
coming days in offering fervent prayer in support of the Cardinal
Electors. We entrust the Church to Divine Providence as we
await the election of the 267th Successor of St Peter. I urge each
Parish Community to celebrate a Votive Mass to the Holy Spirit
on Monday 5th or Tuesday the 7th of May 2025.
