GIFT AID DONATIONS

Donating by gift aid allows the parish to claim a rebate on the tax you have paid on your donation, effectively increasing your donation by 25%. In order to do this though the tax man requires us to verify each year that you are still paying income tax to cover the claim. Unless we are informed to the contrary, we assume you are still paying tax and will claim the rebate. We are also obliged to inform HMRC if you change your name, address or postcode, though in these circumstances there is no need to complete a new Gift Aid Declaration. Please note that these two stipulations are required whether you make your offering by envelope or standing order. Thank you to everybody who donates through Gift Aid. This very simple system makes a significant contribution to our parish finances. Last year we received a rebate of £12869
